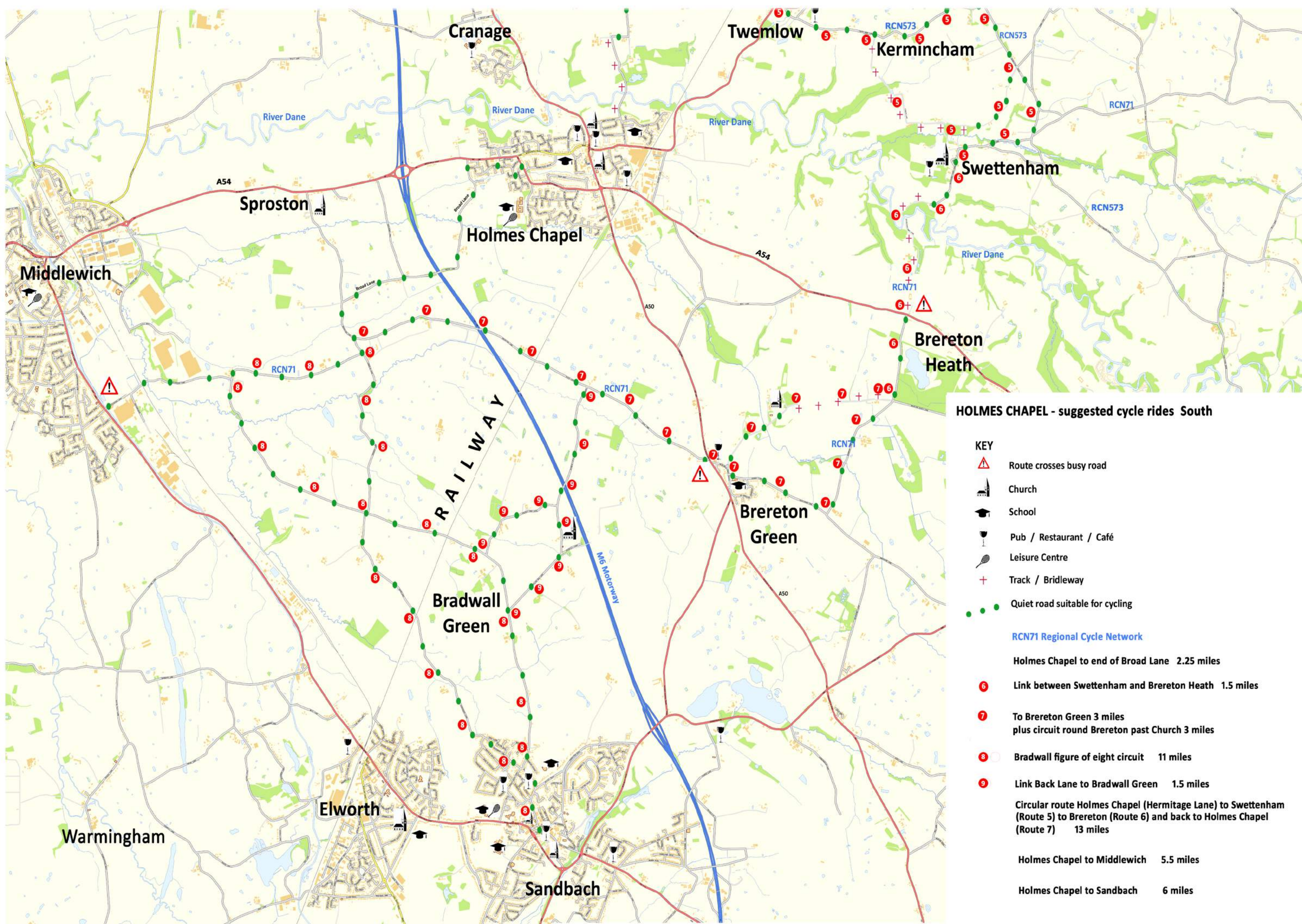


These two maps suggest routes for short and longer cycle rides around Holmes Chapel without having to cycle along the main roads. They follow on from the first Cycling Village map which shows how to navigate Holmes Chapel by bicycle and can be used in combination with it.

The routes to the north and east of Holmes Chapel can be accessed by crossing the Dane on Hermitage Lane. The track is unsurfaced but traffic-free. The routes to the south can be accessed from Broad Lane.

HOLMES CHAPEL - suggested cycle rides South

- KEY**
- Route crosses busy road
 - Church
 - School
 - Pub / Restaurant / Café
 - Leisure Centre
 - Track / Bridleway
 - Quiet road suitable for cycling

- RCN71 Regional Cycle Network**
- Holmes Chapel to end of Broad Lane 2.25 miles
 - Link between Swettenham and Brereton Heath 1.5 miles
 - To Brereton Green 3 miles plus circuit round Brereton past Church 3 miles
 - Bradwall figure of eight circuit 11 miles
 - Link Back Lane to Bradwall Green 1.5 miles
 - Circular route Holmes Chapel (Hermitage Lane) to Swettenham (Route 5) to Brereton (Route 6) and back to Holmes Chapel (Route 7) 13 miles
 - Holmes Chapel to Middlewich 5.5 miles
 - Holmes Chapel to Sandbach 6 miles
